

There are three measurements we need for your Roman Blinds.
Follow the steps below on how to measure up:

## INSIDE A WINDOW RECESS

## Width:

Measure across the recess at several points and give the narrowest measurement.
Then minus 1 cm for clearance so the blind will run freely (see E on the diagram)

## Length:

Measure from the top of the recess to the bottom. It is advisable to do it at several points across thw width to get the shortest measurement (see E on the diagram)

OUTSIDE A WINDOW RECESS

## Width:

Measure the width of the recess and add at least 5 cms on each side for overlapping (see $F$ on the diagram)

## Length:

Measure from the required starting position above the window to the length you require, adding 5 cm on the length

## CHAIN LENGTH

Length: Top of where the blind mechanism will sit to the floor.


E - Measurements needed for recess fitted blind
F - Measurements needed for outside of reccess fitted blind; adding 10 cm to the widrht and 5 cm to the length.
