

There are three measurements we need for your Roman Blinds. Follow the steps below on how to measure up:

## **INSIDE A WINDOW RECESS**

#### Width:

Measure across the recess at several points and give the narrowest measurement.

Then minus 1cm for clearance so the blind will run freely (see E on the diagram)

# <u>Length:</u>

Measure from the top of the recess to the bottom. It is advisable to do it at several points across thw width to get the shortest measurement (see E on the diagram)

#### **OUTSIDE A WINDOW RECESS**

### Width:


Measure the width of the recess and add at least 5cms on each side for overlapping (see F on the diagram)

## Length:

Measure from the required starting position above the window to the length you require, adding 5cm on the length

#### **CHAIN LENGTH**

**Length**: Top of where the blind mechanism will sit to the floor.

F - Measurements needed for outside of reccess fitted blind; adding 10cm to the widrht and 5cm to the length.
